Philadelphia area economic development professional Barry Cassidy will attend the London School of Economics (LSE) in September. Cassidy will be part of the "Cities" program that meets for a week in London every three months, as students fly in from all over the world to attend the week-long sessions.

LSE describes the program as "The Executive MSc in Cities is designed for public, private and third sector leaders who want to deliver large-scale change in cities. Based at LSE Cities, a leading international center that has informed global urban practice for the last 16 years, we deploy the Centre's global network of city leaders and the School's leading urban specialty faculty to put the latest ground-breaking research into business and public action."

The program touches on issues that Cassidy has addressed for over forty years in the public sector including the area of Cities, Societal Changes, Social Cohesion and Urban Economic Development and

Finance. Cassidy seeks to keep his focus on some of the major drivers of urban inequality and poverty.



"I am currently working on a large Transit Oriented Development Project (TOD) and flood map revision in Castle Shannon PA as well as a Refugee Housing development in the City of Pittsburgh. I hope to conclude my work in the United States around the end of December 2019 and concentrate my economic development practice more international." Cassidy said.

Cassidy, who was given Pennsylvania's Society of Tourism Keystone Laurette status as an Agent of Change, has had successful projects on South Street in Philadelphia and Phoenixville in Chester County. He also supervised the revitalization of Downingtown and in the City of Philadelphia had Kensington Avenue from Front Street to Lehigh Avenue. He is currently a resident of Downingtown where he lives with his wife Karen McMichael.
