



Although the feedback we receive is very positive, we have made several policy changes based on the information customers have shared with us."

Educating Customers - Knowledge is power!

Want to know what kind of ants are plaguing your home? 

So, what bug is "hot" this year? Bedbugs! A recent CBS News report on the 15 worst-hit cities in the US, indicates that Philadelphia is number two in the nation.
