#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



The Chamber has used networking tips previously in our emails, in packets of materials for membership orientations, and we have discussed at luncheons and I want to again focus on one of the tips from Shepa Learning Company's "88 Positive Networking Tips."

During this unusual time, personal interaction is not encouraged and as a result many may feel that networking is on hold. As an organization that hears from Members that networking is their main reason for joining the TriCounty Area Chamber of Commerce, our programming has been seriously impacted by the pandemic. Your Chamber wants to continue to provide value to our Membership and we want Members to have access to the benefits that they find most beneficial. The Chamber, just as our Members, has had to pivot and adjust our action plan. As part of the pivot we are offering virtual opportunities for our Members.

A virtual event is a new experience for some and seems impersonal where networking is concerned.

Tip #17 from the "88 Positive Networking Tips" is titled "Use your time wisely." The tip states "at events avoid the temptation to hang out with the people you came with or talk only to people you know. This habit may make your networking more comfortable, but the downside is it limits opportunities to meet new connections. You have invested your precious time to attend the event, make it a worthwhile investment."

In my 20 years in this industry and attending hundreds of events I have welcomed many members and watched them leave the registration table and head right to the people that they know. The zoom meeting opportunity takes the pressure off the participant to seek out new contacts. In every zoom interaction that we are hosting we are providing Members the opportunity to introduce themselves. Members are meeting everyone in attendance, something that they would not necessarily do at an event. The TriCounty Chamber recently started a "Coffee Chat" with our REACH, Empowering and Connecting Women, Group to provide an opportunity to keep our REACH participants connected as our REACH events for April and June had to be cancelled. Participants that may have never met under our normal networking circumstances are having access to building new relationships.



TIP #17 Use your time wisely.

In February we received responses to a survey that we emailed. Responses indicated Members' interest in small group interactions/roundtables. We were working on developing a CEO/Business Owner Roundtable. A perfect scenario would provide our Members the opportunity to meet each other, shake hands, and build relationships in person. Unfortunately we know that perfect scenario would not be doable for at least a couple more months but it felt that there was no better time than now to have an opportunity for business owners and CEOs to have a group of peers that they can share their concerns, problems,

and hopefully solutions with.

During our first meeting of the CEO Roundtable one of the participants stated exactly what this networking tip and this message are highlighting. She looked around the boxes on her screen and was excited for the opportunity to meet her fellow CEO participants that she knew she would not have met at a networking event.



We also want to continue to provide access to information and education as we do through multiple Chamber events.






