It has been the pleasure of the TriCounty Area Chamber of Commerce team to administer your organization over the last 5 months. As you are well aware, the process has not been without its issues.

Please accept this correspondence as my personal apology to each one of you for the invoicing errors that have occurred. I have worked at our organization for over 24 years and I am confident in the skills of our team.

However, we have experienced some issues in learning the capabilities of the database software (which tracks membership, invoicing, event registration, etc.) that Spring-Ford Chamber of Commerce has contracted. It is a much different platform and the procedures to complete the tasks that we can complete internally are limited and have not gone smoothly.

As has been reiterated, the relationship between the Spring-Ford Chamber of Commerce and the TriCounty Area Chamber of Commerce was not a merger but a transactional agreement for the TriCounty Chamber team to provide administrative services for 6 months. Those 6 months conclude on Friday, October 13 at which time the TriCounty Area Chamber of Commerce will be turning over all administration back to the board of directors of the Spring-Ford Chamber of Commerce.

Again, my sincerest apologies for the inconvenience and confusion that the invoice billing has caused. Please note that if you received the previous email and the most recent email (September 5) according to the database records you still have an outstanding balance (those of you that have sent proof of payment – THANK YOU – we are working with the software company to have your account updated) and the Spring-Ford Chamber of Commerce appreciates your continued support.

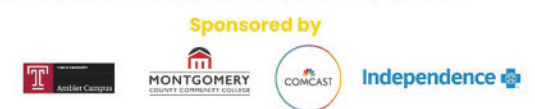
