The Foundation for Pottstown Education is kicking off the annual **IMPACT** Campaign with the second annual A Night at the Races.

This year's **IMPACT** Campaign will begin on Monday September 18th with a goal of raising \$100,000 to support the 3,300 students in the Pottstown School District. The donors of the Foundation have provided more than \$1.4 million during the past 5 years to provide programs such as the Early College Program and Environmental Education, purchase equipment for the Art Departments, Libraries and Career and Technology Education and provide more than 8-students with \$44,000 in scholarships annually.

The Night at the Races is a **FUND** raising event. This event will be held on Saturday October 7th starting at 6:00

PM and held at the Carousel at Pottstown. Guests will bet on the horses on the carousel for a chance to win cash prizes. There will be 10 races during this event. There will also be a wine pull where participants can purchase a ticket and select a mystery bag which has a bottle of wine in it.

Refreshments will be provided by the Pottstown High School Culinary Arts program and will include hot and cold hors d'oeuvres, desserts, iced tea, lemonade and coffee. Participants are able to bring in their own food and beverages.
