Presented by Dennis Marsh of the PA Department of Labor and Industry The bulk of presentation will demonstrate why, how and where business owners must report their new hire data, to be in compliance with state and federal law. The key fact to understand is that this new hire reporting is mandatory under state and federal law. All employers, regardless of their size, industry, occupation, ownership status, etc. are required to report their new hires to the Program, within 20 days of the Hire Date of the newly hired employee. The Program provides numerous ways for employers to report their new hire data timely, securely and accurately to the Commonwealth. These methods will be explained in detail at this meeting.
