

The Trading Post Depot is a veritable antique wonderland and treasure trove not to be missed, where you can browse through a fabulous selection of custom creations and eclectic home decor including architectural salvage, antiques, event rentals, live edge slabs, barn wood and magical found objects each with their own story.

Trading Post Depot's master craftsman, founder and owner Ed Dilello's

entrepreneurial success story is almost as unique as the antiques and wood craft creations he offers. Dilello took up the weekend hobby of buying and selling antiques in May 2004, and within a few months he was hooked, opening his own antiques shop in a 1,500 SF building at the former Moyer Lumber Yard in Schwenksville. "I decided to open up a shop and make a business out of it," Dilello said. "It was the right idea."

The combination of Dilello's natural skill at acquiring select antique items,


along with his outgoing friendly personality, led to rapid growth as his business expanded to eventually take over the entire 50,000 SF lumber yard building. Outgrowing that space, Dilello moved his business to its current Spring City location in 2015. "It was a good situation because at the time the building was for sale and the owners were very nice people and accommodated me with a buy/lease deal," Dilello explains.

"It's been very good." The business has continued to thrive and prosper at the Spring City location, and early this year, Johanna Gilmore was hired as an on-site manager to assist with providing excellent service to the increasingly steady flow of customers, as well as to handle administrative and digital marketing duties.

The antiques market has gone through a dramatic transformation since Dilello started his business in 2004. The advent of eBay and Internet sales, a spate of antiquing-related television shows, and the popularity of reproduction pieces all combined to make the industry much more competitive. "The antique market is not what it was 10-15 years ago," Dilello confirms, "but there's still a demand for the right piece for the right customer."

Dilello's keen eye for finding attractive and special pieces, his large on-site inventory, and his reputation have kept him ahead of his competition. Not one to rest on his laurels however, Dilello added woodworking to his skill set in recent years, becoming a master craftsman of unique wooden farmhouse tables, cus-

tom furniture, and live edge creations in the process!

"We started out with antiques, and along the way diversified more into woodworking," Dilello explains. "The request for farm tables and the live edge business started to increase and become more in demand, and now we are putting 80 percent of our efforts into tables and woodwork and live edge pieces, and 20 percent into antiques. But we still carry an extensive line of selective pieces of antique furniture and collectibles," he said.

Dilello's warm, friendly personality, along with the exceptional quality of his craftsmanship, has earned him a loyal following over the years, and many of his long-term customers from the Schwenksville location still stop in to browse or just visit, and send referrals, and as his reputation throughout the region continues to grow, so does his list of newer customers, many of whom have also become friends with Dilello.

"That's what makes this business we have here today unique and interesting," Dilello explains. "You develop friendships with customers and we still stay in touch. That's been important to me to do that. We're not just about the sale. We're

about the friendship and following up with people. Customers come in as strangers and they leave as friends with smiles on their faces," he said. "That's the thing that has been so fantastic for the last 17 years — And it happens every day. I still remember people who came in to the Schwenksville shop, with babies, and now those babies have grown up and I am building tables for their weddings!"

"It's a very warm feeling when you walk in here," adds manager Johanna Gilmore. "It's a very old school feeling," she said, "and building relationships with people is very important to us. When people come in, even if they are looking for something we don't have, we'll try to direct them somewhere else where they might find it. It's nice to still see and experience that level of customer service."

# LIVE EDGE **CREATIONS**

Dilello has developed and refined his craftsmanship over the years, and he continues to expand his capabilities. "If you can dream it, I can build it," he says. Thanks to Dilello's superb skills, the Trading Post Depot has become famous for one-of-a-kind, "live-edge"

creations including bars, islands, mantels, shelves and their very popular funkyfarmhouse-style tables, with legs either reclaimed, repurposed or custom fabricated from wood or metal. Farmhouse tables come to life blending beautiful history with authentic functionality.

"Every piece is different from every other," Dilello explains. "It might be the table shape or legs or the set-up, or whatever the live edge might be, combining to make something different and unique every time."

To build his one-of-a-kind tables, Dilello selects from perfectly milled tops represented by a variety of beautiful species including mahogany, magnolia, maple and more, to fulfill custom orders and an inventory within the store. All wood is locally sourced from Southeastern Pennsylvania counties and acquired through a special relationship with a saw mill in Elverson, PA. The Trading Post Depot also inventories a large selection of live edge slabs for your own project. "I have a huge inventory of slab or live edge pieces," Dilello said. "All my wood is dried and cured and ready to go. It's a long process of three or four years before each piece can be available to use."
